

## **Northstar Chevelle Club**

### **October 17, 2009 Meeting Minutes**

On October 17, 2009 the meeting of the Northstar Chevelle Club was held at Corvette Specialties in Blaine, MN.

The meeting was called to order @ 12:300 PM by President John Sinna. John took a few minutes to welcome all members and guests present. In total, there were 23 members present, with one person joining at the meeting.

There being no further volunteers or nominations for officers, Larry Lucast made a motion to close the nominations. The motion was seconded by Derek Keifer and carried unanimously.

John Sinna took a few minutes to bring everyone up to date on the 2010 calendar. John Sinna then thru the meeting open for suggestions for 2010 events. Tony Hoffer mentioned a night at North St. Paul, next year and Chris Reid mentioned a night at Anoka. John Delke suggested the club could get involved in preparing meals for 3<sup>rd</sup> world countries and went over some of the details for the members present. Terry Didion suggested a local cruise from Drive Inn to Drive Inn in the metro area and Dave Seitz brought up the idea of a mystery tour. This is something the club could do in the off

season, they usually last 2-days and cost about \$350-\$400 per couple. Ian McAree suggested that CA Performance could host a meeting next year and John Sinna brought up the idea of the Hide Away show for 2010. John Sinna also mentioned Car Craft and suggested we do it the same way as in 2009.

The next agenda item was business directory. John Sinna thought it might be helpful in these tough economic times to make members aware of the various businesses that the members were in. Mr. Sinna suggested that those interested could contact him and it could be put on the website.

Terry Didion went over the trivia questions and prizes were awarded to the winners.
