

**Northstar Chevelle Club**  
**March 28, 2015 Meeting Minutes**

The March 28, 2015, Northstar Chevelle Club meeting was held at the Shakopee, MN home of club member Craig Savina. There were 14 members and guests present. Members enjoyed Domino's pizza and cookies contributed by Craig's wife. President Chris Staniec called the meeting to order at 12:30 P.M.

After a brief welcome, the treasurer's report was given. The current balance in the checking account was approximately \$2,880, a \$20 increase over the previous month's balance. The increase in the balance was attributable to membership renewals, offset by typical monthly expenses.

John Delke provided a report on the website and forum. The website is averaging 1,400 views and 15.8 posts per day. John also indicated the sources of the Club's website traffic. 35% comes from search engine results where the keyword "Chevelles" is used, 34% comes from Google, 10% is attributable to links from the forum, with the remaining 21% coming from various sources. None of the membership reported issues accessing information on either the website or forum.

Chris Staniec indicated that license plates are now available for \$12 each.

Chris also mentioned having a 50/50 raffle at monthly meetings to generate additional funds to cover meeting costs and the Christmas party. The 50/50 raffle will begin at the April meeting.

Chris continued the discussion of volunteers for upcoming meetings and the Christmas party. It was noted by the organizers of last year's Christmas party that the most difficult part was finding a location. There was also discussion around whether Friday night would be better than Saturday, as a lot of venues had Friday available. John Delke will post a reminder on the forum soliciting volunteers to organize the Christmas party.

Chris Staniec provided a few more details about the April meeting, followed by racing at ProKart in Burnsville. Look for those details to be posted on the forum soon.

Official business discussion ended, and the meeting was adjourned.
