

Northstar Chevelle Club October 17th, 2015 Meeting Minutes

The October 17th, 2015, Northstar Chevelle Club meeting was held at Veit Automotive Foundation in Buffalo, MN, prior to a tour of the Foundation's museum and horse stable. Fifteen club members and one guest gathered at 9:30 A.M. Vice President Ron Olson called the meeting to order at 9:35 A.M.

Treasurer Mike Sabby discussed the Treasurer's report. The balance in the checking account was \$2,522, a \$28 decrease from the previous month's balance. The decrease was due to the typical monthly expenses for Yahoo and website costs.

Webmaster John Delke provided a report on the website and forum. The forum averages 1,400 page views per day, with life-to-date page views exceeding 3 million. There are currently 203 registered forum users averaging 15 posts per day. John reemphasized that members should e-mail club-related or member-related pictures to him for posting on the website. There are instructions on the "Members Only" page of the website for sending large quantities. No issues with the website or the forum were reported.

Ron Olson reminded members that a large number of license plates are still available for \$12 each. Two members purchased them at the meeting.

The membership was reminded of the November 21st club meeting and bowling outing at the Mermaid Entertainment and Event Center in Mounds View. Watch your e-mail and the forum for additional details as the date nears.

Elections will take place at the November meeting. Chris Staniec (President), Mike Sabby (Treasurer), John Delke (Webmaster), and Jenny Staniec (Secretary) are willing to continue in their current roles, if elected by the membership. The Vice President position is open for nomination.

The holiday party will be held at the Plymouth Green Mill on December 12th.

The members in attendance unanimously agreed to donate \$50 to the Veit Automotive Foundation.

During open discussion, Larry Lucast indicated that he is ready to begin work on his Chevelle, after 10 years of sitting in the pole barn.

Official business discussion ended, and the meeting was adjourned at 9:57 A.M. Caleb, nephew of Vaughn Veit, museum owner, led the tour and answered questions.
