June 20th, 2020 Meeting Minutes

The June 20th, 2020, Northstar Chevelle Club meeting was held in Public Square Park in Prescott, WI, following a cruise. Twenty-two members and guests gathered as President Hank Millette called the meeting to order at 12:45 P.M.

Mitch Despen mentioned that the Little Log House Antique Power Show, initially scheduled for Friday, July 24th through Sunday, July 26th, has been tentatively rescheduled for October 2nd through October 4th. Whether the event will take place in October depends on restrictions due to COVID-19.

Keith Snider also stated that he would like to host a shop tour and meeting at his residence sometime this year.

We also need to reschedule our previously cancelled tech session at Randy Lewis's in North Branch.

Bowling alleys are currently open at 25% capacity, so we're still hoping to hold our annual Bowling and Elections meeting in November.

Plans for the holiday party were in the works when restaurants and bars were ordered to close. The restaurant we were communicating with has yet to reopen. If plans fall through, Hank and Karen Millette have graciously offered to have a catered holiday party at their home in Columbus, MN. Details will be made available as soon as we know more.
