September 19th, 2020 Meeting Minutes

The September 19th, 2020, Northstar Chevelle Club meeting was held at McLeod County Veterans Memorial Park in Hutchinson, MN, following a cruise that included seventeen people in nine cars. President Hank Millette called the meeting to order at 12:40 P.M.
