April 16th, 2022, Meeting Minutes

The April 16th, 2022, Northstar Chevelle Club meeting was held at the Old Chrysler Garage in Isanti, MN. Fifteen members gathered as President Hank Millette called the meeting to order at 1:50 P.M.

The balance in the checking account is approximately \$2,500. There have been a couple membership renewals, offset by website and forum costs.

No issues were reported with the forum or website.

Registration is open for Street Machine Nationals. Early bird pricing, \$35 for the entire weekend, is available through April 30th. After April through July 13th, registration is \$50. Late and on-site registration from July 14th through July 17th is \$65. Reserved parking is an option again this year at a cost of \$25 for the weekend. You must register for the show before you can reserve parking. The parking reservation system is not yet available. Once it is, all registered participants will receive an e-mail. The Club will **not** be reserving parking spaces on behalf of members. If you do not pay for a reserved spot, you will be responsible for finding an open, unreserved parking spot upon arriving at the show. Also note that the location of the participant entrance has changed. Participants will now enter the Fairgrounds via University of Minnesota Transitway off Como Blvd. They are asking everyone not to line up on Como Avenue earlier than 20 minutes prior to the pre-registration lot opening.

Our next meeting will be a cruise to Classic Rides and Rods in Annandale Saturday, May 14th. They will be grilling for us but asked that we bring a dish to pass. A cruise route is being planned for a 10:30 A.M. arrival time in Annandale.

Plans for June are in the works. We will either be cruising to Fast Freddie's Rod Shop in Eau Claire, WI or attending the roll-in at Unique Classics in Mankato, MN Saturday, June 11th.

The July meeting will be at Street Machine Nationals Saturday, July 16th.

During open discussion, Bryan Flattem mentioned that he plans to resurrect the NCC Facebook page. Only vague references to meetings will be provided there. Meeting details will only be available to paid club members via the forum and e-mail.

Chris Pittman mentioned that The Hub Dyno Garage in Taylor's Falls is having an open house April 30th. Watch for additional details on the forum.
