I saw a few minutes of a TV show that talked about SIMONIZ and the GlassCoat product. I had never heard of the product before.

Apparently it was the first American car wax company and produced the world's first automotive wax in 1910. The company had a steady marketing presence including advertisements on the radio and in print, often touting their slogan, "Motorists Wise, Simoniz."



Although the company was acquired several times over the years the SIMONIZ products can still be found today on-line.

Has anyone used some of their products? Are these suitable for older vehicles?

The part number for the SIMONIZ Original Paste Wax is RT28695-1 and is available for about \$15. GlassCoat is available for \$30 per 2 oz. bottle.
