

## **Northstar Chevelle Club February 18th, 2023, Meeting Minutes**

Most members have been able to get spaces, mostly in our vicinity of Machinery Hill, but still somewhat scattered. We may be able to "trade" spaces with other participants to get our club closer together. It seems there was also not a standard for who received the emails from the show, or again for the parking reservation email. Bruce L brought up something he saw which mentioned club parking and that we would want to look into it as a club and see what needs to be done to reserve the spaces needed for next year.

We will attempt to drop a business card in non-member chevelles at the show and snap a pic, hoping to draw in new "blood" to the club. Current business cards will need to have the forum web info blacked out as it is no longer valid.
